FYI: John B. Marshall, an ardent Republican, founded Marshall's Band in 1884 to aid in the campaign of James G. Blaine and John A. Logan, Republican candidates for President and Vice-President. Ironically, the first paying engagement that the band played was a local jubilee procession for the victorious Democratic ticket of Grover Cleveland and Thomas Hendricks.

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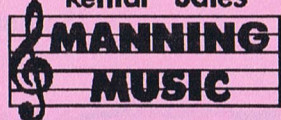
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
